



TRACS “Copy Forward” Fields Job Aid

SUMMARY: The “Copy Forward” functionality gives users the option to copy an existing grant and corresponding project statements to a new grant in TRACS. Copying a grant will be a time saver for users who enter grants that share most of the same information. Some information will need to be re-entered and all information should be reviewed. Note: Project Statement Approvals, FBMS link and Performance Reports will not copy forward.

Note: Due to the structural differences between a CMS and project-based grant, it is not possible to switch between them in the copy forward functionality. A CMS grant cannot be copied as a project-based grant or vice versa.

Below is a list of the fields that will copy and the fields that will not copy.
